Important safety information

Parents and carers **should not drive up or down or park** on **Cheviot View or Parker Place** on school days between **8:15am to 9:15am and 2:45pm to 3:45pm**. Cheviot View and Parker Place are covered by the **Seghill First School Pedestrian and Cycle Zone.** This includes parents and carers who are dropping off and collecting children from Red and Green class or parking in either street to drop off or collect from any part of our school.

Children In Purple and Blue class must be **collected from the classroom door**. We do not allow children to leave our classrooms to be sent to an adult waiting in a car on Barrass Avenue.

Children should wear a plain white t-shirt, plain black or navy shorts or joggers, sandshoes or trainers and their school sweatshirt or cardigan to school on their PE days. Please ensure long hair is tied back for PE. Children cannot wear earrings for PE. If your child cannot remove their own earrings, they should not wear them on PE days. Staff are unable to remove earrings for children.

School meals and packed lunch

We offer an excellent schools meals service at our school, cooked on site by our fantastic cook Mrs Rogage. We have a two week rolling menu. A copy of the menu is on the front page of the school website. Please speak to Miss Best in the office if your child has any **food allergies** or **food intolerances** and we will set up a food plan for your child.

Children in Nursery, Year 3 and Year 4

Parents and carers of children in Nursery, Year 3 and Year 4 have to pay for their child's school meal unless they are eligible for Free School Meals. Meals cost £2.40 per day and need to be paid for using the Schoolcomms app. We are a cashless school and do not accept cash for school meals.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2

Parents and carers of children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 do not have to pay for their child's school meal, as meals are provided free of charge due to the government's Universal Infant Free School Meals initiative.

How to apply for Free School Meals

Please do apply for Free School Meals via this <u>link</u>, even if your child currently gets their meals for free in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. If you are eligible for Free School Meals you will also get **free milk** for your child and other benefits, such as **vouchers during school holidays**. We also get extra funding, which is spent on providing extra opportunities and resources for the children.

Packed lunch

Please pack a range of foods that your child likes. A few small things are much better than one big thing.

We do ask children to put anything they haven't eaten back in their packed lunch box so parents and carers can see what they have eaten.

Please don't pack sweets or pop in your child's packed lunch box.

School uniform orders

There are a number of school uniform orders ready for collection in the school office which have not been paid for. If you have ordered school uniform, please pay for it on **Schoolcomms** so the order can be sent out to you.

Jeans for Genes- advance notice

Staff and children are invited to wear denim and pay a donation on Friday 20 September to support the Jeans for Genes charity. This charity does amazing work to support families where a child has a genetic disorder. We will be learning about genetic disorders and the work of the charity in assemblies in the next few weeks.

Wraparound

We are proud to offer both a **breakfast club** and **after school club**. Breakfast club starts at 7:30am and takes place in the Club Room. After school club takes place in the Red classroom and closes at 5:30pm. If you would like to book your child in to either of the clubs, please do so using the Schoolcomms app. Sessions need to be booked **24 hours in advance** and need to be **paid for at the time of booking**. Children will be provided with a snack and a drink. Foods that we typically offer are cereal, toast, yoghurt, porridge, crumpets and pain au chocolat. We have small numbers at the clubs so staff will provide what the children like- within reason! Miss Welton will be leading all of the breakfast club sessions. She will also do some of the after school sessions, alongside other staff. Please drop your child off at the Club Room for breakfast club and collect them from Red classroom for after school club.
