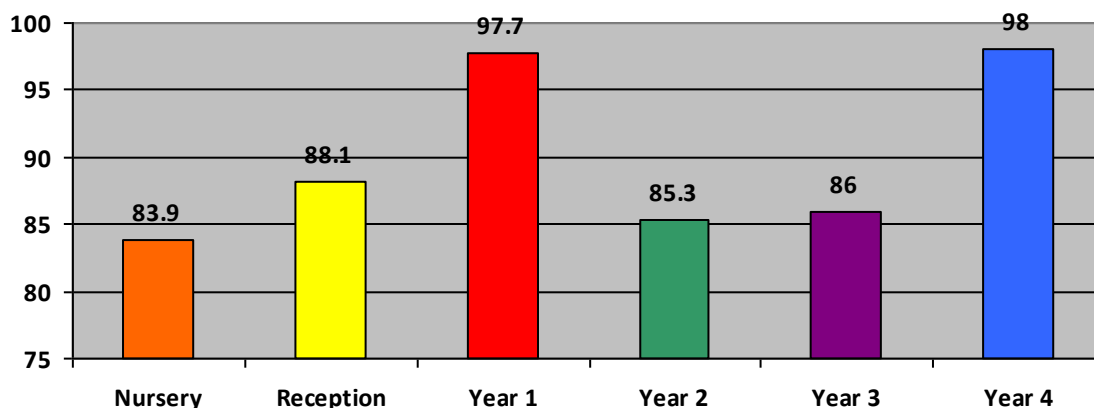
Whole school attendance this week 89.4%
