### UEFA Euros 2024

Children in Year 4 have been learning about **countries in Europe** through the context of the **UEFA European championships**. We have been looking at all countries in Europe, and focusing on the 24 countries taking part in the Euros. We have been looking at the names of the countries, using our knowledge of cognates to work out the country names. For example-

La Croatie and l'Italie	the children could guess that these are Croatia and Italy as the words in French
	look very similar to the meaning in English. They are cognates.
L'Allemagne and l'Ecosse	the children couldn't guess that these are Germany and Scotland as the words
	are not similar to their meaning in English. They are not cognates.

We will be looking at the capital cities and flags for each country and writing a player profile in French using model sentences.
