### Reminder for all Nursery families about applications for Reception places

Parents and carers of children in Nursery must apply for a place for their child in Reception. This is done online via the School Admissions portal. Please follow this linkschool admissions portal

Applications must be made by **15 January 2025**. Please don't miss this deadline. Sometimes parents and carers assume that their child will get a place in Reception due to them having a place in Nursery. This is untrue. 16 April 2025 is National Offers Day, when parents and carers are informed by Northumberland County Council which school their child is being offered a place in from September 2025.

#### Santa's reading challenge

Santa's reading challenge started on Monday. Our literacy lead, Mrs Watson, sent out information about the reading challenge and the children have their bookmarks for the challenge. It is important that children continue to read in the run up to Christmas as part of their normal routine, as this maintains fluency and interest in books.
