
Attendance



Walk to school month

October is **Walk to School month** and we are taking part in the county council's Walk to School month initiative. Walk to School Month is a global event held each October to encourage children to walk, bike, or scoot to school, promoting health, safer streets, and cleaner air by reducing traffic congestion and car dependency. We are planning activities for each week in October to try to achieve these aims. The key events for parents and carers to be aware of are-

Week beginning Monday 29 September week 1 launch week

Friday 03 October we are hosting **Funky Feet Friday, when** all children and staff are invited to wear either their **favourite shoes**, or to **bling some shoes or boots** and wear them to school. There will be prizes for the most creative entries.

All children will be given a **My Walking Week Diary** and asked to complete it at home. All completed entries will receive a prize.

Week beginning Monday 06 October week 2 walk to school week

During week 2, we want the children to **walk to school** as many times as they can. Class teachers will be recording how the children get to school each day to see how many walking journeys we can record for our school. We know that some children live quite far from school, so walking may not be possible.

Week beginning Monday 13 October week 3 wheel to school week

During week 2, we want the children to **wheel to school** as many times as they can. Class teachers will be recording how the children get to school each day to see how many wheeled journeys we can record for our school. Children are encouraged to ride their **bike or scooter** to school during wheel to school week= no electric or battery-operated vehicles please.

We will be talking about the importance of always wearing a helmet for scooting or cycling. Children will be asked to decorate a helmet template for homework. There will be prizes for the most creative decorated helmets, which will be added to a whole school display

We are asking parents and carers to **take a picture** of their child riding their bike or scooter and send it in to school. All wheel to school week pictures will be added to the whole school display.

Week 4 week beginning Monday 20 October be bright be seen week

We will be talking about the importance of always wearing highly visible clothes and accessories while riding bike or scooters and when out and about.

Hopefully you will be able to see our completed whole school walk to school month display in Celebration Assembly on Friday 24 October.
