

Ofsted inspection

As you are aware, our school was inspected by **Ofsted** this week. We were visited by two inspectors on Tuesday and one inspector on Wednesday. Inspectors visited all classes, met with children, staff, governors and representatives from the local authority, looked at children's work, teachers' planning and school records and documents. They carried out "deep dives" into early reading, maths and RE, which means that they look very thoroughly into how we plan, teach and assess in these specific areas.

Thank you to all of you who took the time to respond to the parents' survey and share your views about our school. From receiving the notification phonecall at 10:00am on Monday to leaving school after 7:00pm on Wednesday, it has been a very intense few days. What was very clear from the outcome of the inspection was how lovely are children are and how very hard every member of staff works to get the best possible outcomes for every one of our children.

Although we have had initial feedback, we are not able to share that with anyone at this stage. The inspection report will be sent to school in the next few weeks and as soon as we are able to you, we will send a copy to all families.
