
Attendance

School uniform policy change

At our governing body meeting this week we reviewed a number of policies, including our **school uniform policy**. Governors have agreed to change the policy, which now says children can wear **plain black flat heeled school shoes or plain black trainers** to school.

We previously had a no trainers policy for school. We have listened to **feedback from parents and carers** who have said that buying trainers to wear two days a week for PE lessons and school shoes for three days a week is causing financial strain.

Children can of course continue to wear school shoes. There is no expectation that anyone should go out and buy trainers for school. We know that some children have quite brightly coloured trainers for PE. There will be a transitional stage between now and what will happen when your child grows out of their current school shoes and trainers. If you want your child to wear trainers for school and PE, please buy plain black trainers the next time you buy new ones. If you want your child to wear trainers for PE and shoes for school, please continue to do so.
