

Meeting for parents and carers with class teachers

We have arranged for parents and carers to meet with their child's class teacher on Monday 21 October and Wednesday 23 October.

It is really helpful if you can bring your child along to the meeting, so they are involved in the conversations. Meetings will take place in the hall. Please use the main entrance on Cheviot View.

Meetings on **Monday** 21 October will be for children in **Nursery**, **Year 1**, **Year 2** and **Year 4**. Meetings will start at **3:30pm**.

Meetings on **Wednesday** 23 October will be for children in **all classes**. Meetings will start at **2:30pm**. If you have an appointment between 2:30pm and 3:15pm, your child will be brought to the hall for your appointment, and you can take them home following the appointment.

All children in Years 1 to 4 will be dismissed from the Year 3 and 4 classrooms on Wednesday at 3:15pm.

Tax Free Childcare

Tax-Free Childcare (TFC) is a new Government scheme which will give eligible families up to £2,000 per child towards childcare costs, including the fees for breakfast, after-school and holiday clubs. If you get Tax Free Childcare, you'll set up an online childcare account for your child. For every £8 you pay into this account, the government will pay in £2 to use to pay your provider. (Nursery parents: You can get Tax-Free Childcare at the same time as 15 or 30 hours free childcare if you're eligible for both).
