
Attendance

Mrs Askew, our computing lead, has organised a **range of activities** for children in all year groups for Safer Internet Day, which will complement our existing computing curriculum.



Supervision of children before school

Classroom doors open every morning at 8:45am and close at 8:50am. Parents and carers are welcome to bring their children on site before 8:45am to allow time for socialising and play.

Recently, there has been an increasing trend of staff opening the classroom door and immediately being faced with **issues that have happened on the yard before school starts** (before 8:45am). This is predominantly in key stage 2. Responding to these issues leads to a delayed start to the day and places staff in a difficult position as they have not seen or heard first hand what has happened.

The **supervision of children** before the start of the school day is the **responsibility of parents and carers**. Parents and carers of all children should be waiting with their child at the allocated area for their year group until their child enters the classroom, which is what the very vast majority of parents and carers do now. We are aware that the weather has been awful recently, but parents and carers should not be in their cars while their children are unsupervised on the yard. Please continue to support us to ensure a smooth and safe start to the school day for all children.
