Information about financially motivated exploitation alert

Globally there has been an increase in reports of **children and young people** being **victims of financially motivated sexual extortion**, often referred to in the media as 'sextortion'.

We have been asked to share <u>this link</u> to an update from CEOPs and the National Crime Agency, which provides more information about this subject. Some people may think this issue would not apply to a first school, but any child who has **access to a mobile phone or the internet** could become involved. Please read up on this subject so you are aware of the risks and dangers.
