If you would like to attend either event, please use the booking system on School Gateway. In the payments section, please pick either **Thursday 12 June Father's Day breakfast** OR **Monday 16 June Father's Day lunch**. Add your choice to the basket and then pay. If you would like a **meat free choice**, please email Miss Best at <u>schooladmin@seghillschool.co.uk</u> so it is pre-ordered for you. The payment portal is open now and will close on **Friday 06 June**. We will not be reopening the payment portal after this date as the food has to be ordered by then.

#### Arrangements

Breakfast will be served at 9:00am on Thursday 12 June. Please drop your child off at their classroom and come to the school hall.

Lunch will be served between 11:45am and 1:00pm on Monday 16 June. There will be more than one sitting for lunch on Monday. The timing for your lunch will be on your ticket.

Places for each event are limited to 40 guests per day. You will be issued with a ticket before the events.

If your child is in **Orange class** and they do not usually stay for lunch, please make sure that they ask for a school meal on Monday 16 June or provide a packed lunch for them.
