
Attendance

Revised arrangements for Breakfast Club and After School Club and Childcare Choices tax free childcare scheme

Breakfast Club

Places are available to book in advance at Breakfast Club as they are now. We are increasing the cost of Breakfast Club from £3.50 to **£4.00 per session** from 01 January 2026.

After school club

We are introducing a new two-tier system for booking After School Club slots from 01 January 2026 -

- **one hour** of childcare at after school club from 3:15pm to 4:15pm will cost **£5.00**;
- **more than one hour** of childcare at after school club from 3:15pm until after 4:15pm will cost **£8.00**.

Both of these booking options will be available on School Gateway. Parents and carers can pick the appropriate option at the time of booking. This is the first price increase since we started to offer wraparound services 15 years ago. Please see **Miss Best** in the school office if you have any queries.


