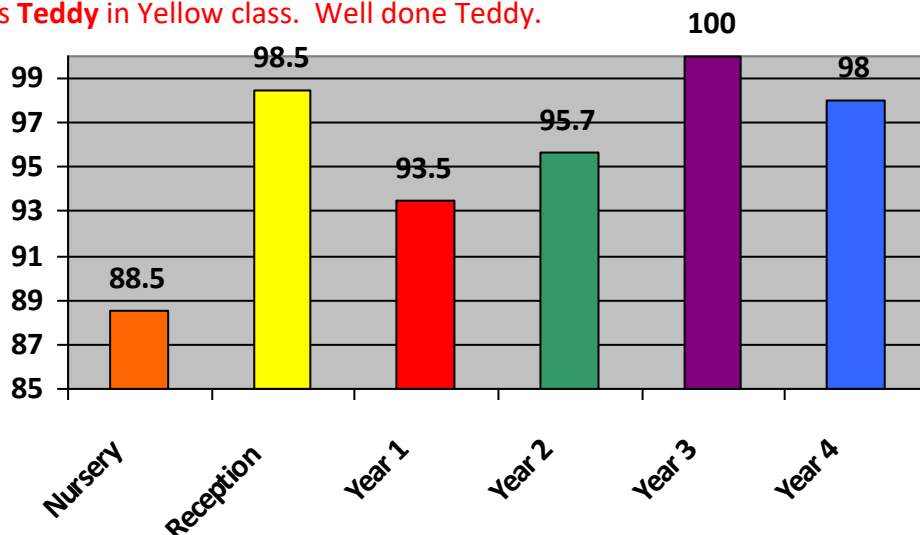
Whole school attendance year to date 95.4%
