### Chickenpox update

I wrote to parents and carers last week regarding chickenpox. Although we did have a number of cases in school, we are not aware of any current cases of chickenpox. I wanted to share a couple of reminders about chickenpox-

Children can have chickenpox **more than once**. If they have fluid filled blisters or spots, this could be chickenpox, even if they have already had it.

Children can return to school when the **spots have scabbed over** and are no longer wobbly or filled with fluid. Please do not keep your child at home until every scab has disappeared. As long as the spots have scabbed over, they can return to school.

Children with chickenpox are **contagious in the period before the spots** appear. This makes it almost impossible to stop chickenpox spreading between children.

Like all schools, we have a number of cases of chickenpox every year. Hopefully we are past the worst of it.

### Seghill First School Pedestrian and Cycle Zone

Parents and carers **should not drive up or down or park** on **Cheviot View or Parker Place** on school days between **8:15am to 9:15am and 2:45pm to 3:45pm**. This includes parents and carers who are dropping off and collecting children from Red and Green class or parking in either street to drop off or collect from any part of our school.

Some of you may have seen the parking enforcement officer in Cheviot View earlier this week. Some parents have been issued with a **fixed penalty notice** for parking on double yellow lines, stopping on the zig zag lines outside the main entrance or driving up or down Cheviot View or Parker Place during the restricted times. I spoke to the parking enforcement officer, who said that there are going to be **regular parking patrols** around our school. The issuing of fixed penalty notices is nothing to do with us. However, I can only stress again that if parents and carers do stop on the zig zag lines, park on double yellow lines or drive up or down Cheviot View or Parker Place during the restricted times and they are spotted by the parking enforcement officer, they will be issued with a **fixed penalty notice**. **The pedestrian and cycle zone is in place to keep our children safe.**



### Early Years focus

Children in Early Years have been reading The Colour Monster story. This week we made symmetrical colour monsters. The children were so excited to 'watch the magic' as we painted one side of the monster then folded it in half to create the other side.
