Attendance

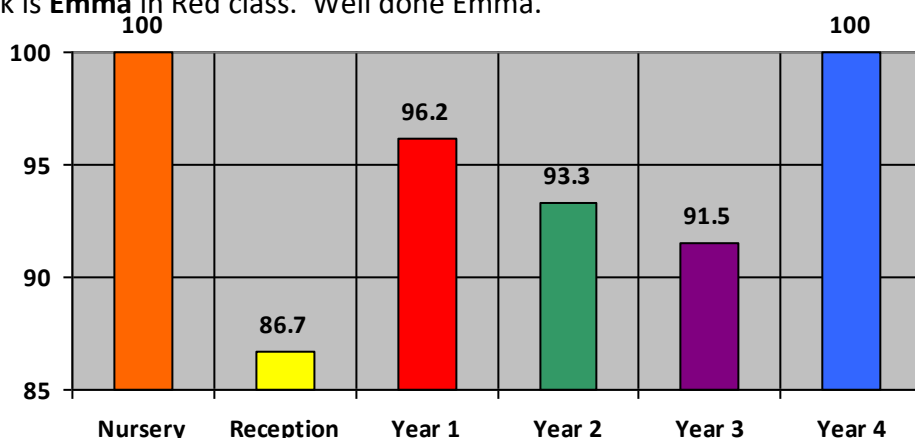
Whole school attendance year to date 92.3%
